Generate Revenue Streams With Few Costs— 1:00 p.m. – 1:45 p.m. - Les Cèdres Room

Session Leader: *Jessica Teckson* - *Radio & Media Relations Manager, News Canada*

Jessica Teckson is the Radio and Media Relations Manager at News Canada which creates and distributes contents – articles, videos & radios across Canada. Jessica has been with News Canada for over four years where she has cultivated relationships with editors across the country. Her experience makes her an expert in content marketing and digital strategy.

SESSION: Most new schemes to generate revenue streams usually cost both time and money. Jessica will show how a new video player can help your business do so without investing money and time in producing video content. It will tie in to your own DoubleClick account by allowing you to place ads before and between the videos, with you taking 100% of the revenue.

Session Leader: *Richard Tardif* - *Executive Director, QCNA*

Richard studied business, environmental science and journalism at Concordia University and began his journalism career as a freelancer in 1996 specializing in environmental issues, political and business affairs before joining The Eastern Door newspaper in Kahnawake in 2006 as a general reporter, photographer and later as the assistant editor, winning a number of awards. Richard began his role as Executive Director of the Quebec Community Newspapers Association in February 2012.

SESSION: If the QCNA had access to \$10 million over a three-year period, how would you spend it? That's the \$10 million question. The purpose of the session is preparatory to help the Quebec Community Newspapers Association map out and implement a comprehensive three-year funding strategy. QCNA would benefit from member ideas and input.



Defending Your Newspaper Against Hackers - 2:30 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. - Les Cèdres Room

Session Leader: *Terry Cutler* - *President/Owner, Cyology Labs*

Terry Cutler is a cybersecurity expert and one of the world's foremost ethical hackers ... and unethical hackers know it. Thousands of people, families, and businesses know it too, and have come to Terry to help them out of sensitive situations and to protect themselves from future threats. Terry is frequently called on by local and national media organizations when any hacking story breaks, because he understands the mind of the hacker. He is a hacker ... but an ethical one.

SESSION: Terry will provide examples of newspapers that have been hacked, and what you can do to prevent your newspaper from becoming another victim. Terry will also introduce the latest tricks hackers are preparing to use to steal your personal identity.
